<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deliver the Computing curriculum in line with the DfE guidance.</li> <li>• Provide supervised access to the internet, email/messaging and a learning platform.</li> <li>• Ensure that our internet service provider operates a filtering system which restricts access to inappropriate materials.</li> <li>• Provide each child when they enter Year 1 with safe and secure passwords, allowing them access to the school's learning platform and other web-based programs. Our learning platform and other web-based programs enable your child access to their accounts anywhere where they can connect to the internet.</li> <li>• Teach every child how to access their accounts and use them and the internet safely and responsibly.</li> <li>• Monitor the children's use of their learning platform. The Administrator can access all messages sent by the children. Inappropriate messages are re-directed to the Administrator.</li> <li>• Take any allegations of cyber-bullying seriously and will investigate in accordance with the school's Anti-Bullying Policy.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Give permission for our child to use the internet under supervision at school and have access to a learning platform from Year 1. We understand that the learning platform will be available to the children on any devices which have access to the internet.</li> <li>• Adhere to the school's social media guidelines to ensure the safeguarding of all children.</li> <li>• Take responsibility for ensuring our child has safe access to the internet (e.g. through managing parental controls).</li> <li>• Understand and agree with the guidelines given in the 'As a Child I will.....' section for the acceptable use of the internet and have discussed these with our child.</li> <li>• Discuss with our child the importance of keeping their passwords secure, so that their accounts are not compromised in any way.</li> <li>• Understand that our child will not be permitted access to the internet or their learning platform account until this signed agreement has been returned to school.</li> <li>• Understand that if our child breaks this agreement, the use of the internet or learning platform may be withdrawn.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only use computer devices if I have permission from an adult.</li> <li>• Only click on icons and links when I know that they are safe.</li> <li>• Only send friendly and polite emails/messages.</li> <li>• Keep my passwords safe.</li> <li>• Always tell an adult if I see something on a screen that I don't like.</li> </ul>
