As Sportspeople we will be developing our skills in throwing, catching and hitting. We will be using these skills to participate in team games.

As Artists we will experience printing with a range of materials and designing a printing block to create a repeating pattern.

In R.E we will be thinking and talking about the natural world and why it is special to us. We will also be learning about Hindu nature gods.

In Computing we will be developing skills in controlling a robot on screen and a programmable toy. We will also be making a pictogram and using it to answer questions.

As Design Technicians we will be talking about how to construct products and making simple plans before making animals. In Food, we will be using tools safely to prepare fruit for a fruit salad at snack time.

As Scientists we will be describing and comparing the structure of a variety of common animals including birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles and mammals. We will be identifying basic parts of the human body, and learning about our senses. We will continue to observe changes across the seasons.

As Historians we will be finding out about the King and the Royal Family. We will be asking and answering questions about old and new artefacts and pictures.

As Musicians we will be listening and responding to rhythms.
