Year 2

In English, we will be writing stories, non-chronological reports and recounts. We will be reading and responding to fiction and non-fiction texts.

In Maths, we will be continuing to solve problems involving the four operations and we will explore fractions, times, statistics and position and direction.

As Sportspeople, we will be learning to improve our skills linking to Athletics. We will learn to improve our throwing techniques in order to improve accuracy, as well as develop fundamental movement skills linked to agility, balance and coordination.

As Scientists, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be comparing things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will learn to identify the different habitats that living things call their homes, and understand how different habitats provide for the basic needs of animals and plants and looking at food chains.

In Computing we will be learning about control through creating an algorithm of a simple everyday task, as well as creating an algorithm to draw a shape. We will learn to make a simple tally or bar chart use coding skills to make objects change direction.

As Design Technicians, we will be learning about cooking and nutrition. We will understand and explain what it means to be hygienic and describe the properties of the ingredients we are using. We will also be designing bug hotels, thinking about the needs of different minibeasts.

In Geography, we will be learning about some physical features within our own locality and explain what makes a locality special. We will describe some places that are not near the school and describe a place outside of Europe, using geographical words.

As Historians, we will explore how our local area was different in the past and give examples of how things are different in our lives to the lives of our Grandparents. We will also be finding out about the life of famous people and events around the world.

In R.E, we will be learning why people have different views about the idea of God.

As Artists, we will be developing our observational and artist skills while working with different types of medium, particularly pastels.

In PSHE, we will be learning how to build positive and healthy relationships and how to cope positively with change.
